Campus Access — Important Notes

Park Families,

Park's buildings will remain closed following spring break, but the campus (*green spaces, woods, trails, etc.*) is open until further notice. It is particularly beautiful at this time of year — and our groundskeeping team has done an incredible job over the break caring for our wonderful facility in our absence.

You are welcome to visit campus, but it is essential that we use the facility responsibly. Spending time outside can be a respite to the concerns and stressors that are part of our new realities, and should be enjoyed fully; we must do so being mindful that we are all part of a critical community effort to limit the spread of COVID-19.

If you and/or your family members go to Park, please know:

- **Playgrounds are closed.** Please do not touch playground equipment or allow children to touch playground equipment.
- **Social distancing guidelines should be adhered to.** Stay apart from people, six feet or more. *If you encounter others, say your hellos from a distance.*
- **Gatherings are prohibited.** Please do not participate in gatherings — either planned or impromptu.
- **Lacrosse, soccer, basketball, field hockey, etc. are prohibited.** Outside of your family unit, please do not participate in team sports where close contact is inevitable and equipment is shared.

(As always, keep dogs on a leash — for the safety and well-being of all on campus.)

We hope to keep Park's 100 acres accessible throughout this public health crisis; if circumstances change, we will notify the community.
